Day 3 – 23rd Mar: TOKYO-MT. FUJI – HAKONE – KYOTO



Kawaguchiko to an observation deck near the peak of Mount Tenjo. From the observation deck, which sits more than 1000 meters above sea level, there are panoramic views of the lake below and of Mount Fuji. Have local lunch. Later transfer from Mt. Fuji to Hakone. Hakone region to enjoy a cruise

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Mt. Fuji. Head up to the 5th Station along the Subaru Line. The 5th Station is situated at 2,300 meters (7,546 ft) above sea level. At this height, you will be amazed at spectacular, breathtaking views from above the clouds. The Mount Fuji Panoramic Ropeway ascends 400 meters from the eastern shore of Lake



on the stunning Lake Ashi. Lake Ashi in Hakone has a circumference of 40 km and was formed from a damming of a river. Popular as a spot to view Mt. Fuji, it is a famous tourist spot for Hakone. Hakone Shrine buildings are well advertised by its huge torii gates, one standing prominently in the lake and two others over the main street of Moto-Hakone. Later transfer from Hakone to Kyoto by Train. On arrival at Kyoto, have dinner & proceed to Hotel for check in.

Day 4 – 24th Mar: KYOTO



Have breakfast in hotel. Proceed for Kyoto city tour. Visit Fushimi Inari Shrine is famous for its thousands of vermilion torii gates, which straddle a network of trails behind its main buildings. Nijo Castle was built in 1603 as the Kyoto residence of Tokugawa Ieyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Period (1603-1867). Have local lunch. Then proceed to Kinkakuji is formally known as Rokuonji, the temple was the retirement

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villa of the shogun Ashikaga Yoshimitsu, and according to his will it became a Zen temple of the Rinza sect after his death in 1408. Have dinner & stay overnight.

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch (Local) & Dinner(Indian)

Day 5 – 25th Mar : KYOTO-HIMEJI-HIROSHIMA

Have breakfast & check out from Hotel. Proceed to Himeji. Himeji Castle is both as a national treasure and a world heritage site. Unlike many other Japanese castles, it was never destroyed by war, earthquake or fire and survives to this day as one of the country's twelve original castles. Himeji Central Park is a theme park that includes not only a safari and an amusement park but a swimming pool and a skating rink. Later proceed to Hiroshima. On arrival, have dinner & check in hotel. Stay overnight in Hiroshima.

Day 6 – 26th Mar : HIROSHIMA-OSAKA



Have breakfast & check out from hotel. Miyajima is a small island less than an hour outside the city of Hiroshima. It is officially named Itsukushima, Japanese for "shrine island", because the most famous giant torii gate, which at high tide seems to float on the water. The sight is ranked as one of Japan's three best views. The centuries-old Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima is the source of both the island's fame and its name. The A-Bomb Dome, also known as the Hiroshima Peace

Memorial, is what remains of the former Prefectural Industrial Promotion Hall. Hiroshima's Peace Memorial Park is one of the most prominent features of the city.) 4. Hiroshima National Peace Memorial Hall for the Atomic Bomb Victims (The Hall was founded by the Japanese national government to mourn the atomic bomb victims in 2002 and designed by Kenzo Tange. Drop at railway station. Proceed to Osaka. On arrival, have dinner & check in hotel in Osaka.

Day 7 – 27th Mar : OSAKA



Have breakfast, proceed for Osaka City Tour. Visit Osaka Castle, The construction of Osaka Castle started in 1583 on the former site of the Ishiyama Honganji Temple, which had been destroyed by Oda Nobunaga thirteen years earlier. Kuromon Market is a fascinating market in central Osaka. There seems to be an endless supply of strange and interesting stalls for tourists to have a look and maybe purchase something. No chain stores here, just

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locals selling their goods. Dotonbori, a popular shopping and entertainment district and is also known as a food destination. At night it is lit by hundreds of neon lights and mechanized signs. Shinsekai is Osaka's "new world," a district that was developed before the war and then neglected in the decades afterwards. At the district's center stands Tsutenkaku Tower, the nostalgia evoking symbol of Shinsekai. Have dinner & overnight stay.

Have breakfast, check out from hotel. Take domestic flight to Tokyo to flight back to India.
